Old Business

Saling- None

Roads- Rick reported Durapatching on Fairmount and Parr and getting a load of mulch for the playground.

Safety- Saling took a call from Jim Grady of Ritchey Rd. that the intersection of Ritchey and Blue Jay needed mowed, Rick mowed it and blew a tire. Saling will refer all such calls to the county as Blue Jay is county road and they are not doing much mowing this year.

Zoning- The Inspector reported taking 5 phone calls and issued one permit for a new build @ 9315 Hirst Rd. since last meeting. The trustees held a hearing and passed a Junk Motor Vehicle resolution for the removal of the junk truck at 11161 Flintridge Rd.

Fiscal Officer-Long- Read the 2 resolutions authorizing the auditor to supply the township with figures for the road and bridge and fire levy 3 year renewals. Trustees passed both resolutions. Trustees also discussed the condition of the building and cleaning being done and possibility of a maintenance person.
