

The board held a regular meeting on 7-2-18 at the township building. At 7:00 PM Jeremy Saling- President called the meeting to order. The following also were present: Trustees-Dave Lang, Jay Clark, Fiscal Officer-Molly Long, Road Worker- Rick Johnson, resident Kenneth Johnson, County Commissioner-Rick Black, Shelly Co. rep-Ryan Packard and Kokosing Co. rep-Mary.

The trustees signed the approved minutes from the previous meeting.

Fairview road OPWC grant bids were opened from the following:

Trustees agreed to award the bid to the Shelly Co. Motion made by Lang, 2nd by Clark, vote unanimous.

Lang made a motion to award the new garage project to Wills Construction, 2nd by Clark, vote unanimous.

Lang made a motion to accept the proposal from Shelly Co. for chip/seal for Dodds & Springhill in the amount of \$24,892.60. 2nd by Clark, vote unanimous.

Old Business

Lang- Reported that Rick took care of water issue on Franks Rd. Got a verbal estimate for a 100 ft. well for the new garage from Mount in the amount of \$7,000. Septic system requires a soil sample and area measurement. The health dept. then makes a determination of what system is needed.

Clark- Reported that the health dept is cleaning up the property on Ritchey Rd.

New Business

Lang- Reported that Morrison's on Springhill have requested a lot split but the county wont' give an address until drive way is in and speed limit needs to be changed to 45 mph. LCATS is doing a study to change, then will be submitted to ODOT. Fuel delivery is cancelled until salt tipple is down and tanks are moved across the street.

Clark- Reported that Ed Fuentes complained about rain coming down the road and ending up in his basement.

Saling- Took call from 5284 Pleasant Chapel Rd. re: dead deer and ditch plugged-county did their part.

Public Comment- Rick Black-County Commissioner brought campaign propaganda and gave a little update on what the county commissioners have been doing.

Roads- Rick reported people bringing dogs to the cemetery and letting them run and do their business, feels a sign is needed. Trustees discussed and agreed, Rick will get Jackie Duston to make a sign that says "NO DOGS ALLOWED". He got new blades for the AC. Will begin to tear down the salt tipple.

Safety- None

Zoning-Inspector Duda reported that he met with Mother Mary re: 5 acres that she wanted to houses on. He told her a variance would be needed. She also said that she wanted to build a monastery. Township would need detailed information to proceed.
